



Caring for your new porcelain bathtub:

BATHTUB CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Please keep this information for future reference

The “slip-resistant” pattern on the bottom of this bathtub provides for a safer bathing experience. This slip-resistant pattern conforms to ASTM Designation: F462 Standard Consumer Safe Specification for Slip-Resistant Bathing Facilities

Under normal conditions, this bathtub should be cleaned with a mild detergent or soap and water however, the use of ***Bar Keepers Friend and a nylon brush*** is highly recommended for best results on ***surface rust, stubborn stains and the “slip-resistant” surface.***

Bar Keepers Friend (www.barkeepersfriend.com) is a cleanser that is not harmful to your person or the environment and can be purchased at all Wal Marts, Home Depots and most large retail supermarkets.

1. Wet the entire tub surface.
2. Apply Bar Keepers Friend to the “surface rust or stubborn stain”.
3. The use of a nylon brush to scrub the surface allows cleaning access between the slip-resistant texture.
4. Rinse thoroughly with water

Note: DO NOT use any type of Comet or Ajax abrasive cleansers - 3M or Brillo scouring pad on the “slip-resistant” surface or bathtub. The use of these (abrasive) products will cause surface rust and may result in damage or the removal of the “slip-resistant” surface.
